Public Comment: Denise Sher and neighbor Dominic Calandrella spoke to the board about increasing security enforcement and the possibility of civilian patrol.

- <u>Hewlett Bay Fire Department Report</u> for month of November 2021 was reported by Village Clerk Ryder due to Fire Commissioner Tariq Khan being absent.

## Committee Reports:

- Public Works Report: VC Ryder mentioned that the GOSR project has been completed.
  Our trucks are being serviced and prepped for the winter months ahead.
- Willow Pond Update: Mayor Weiss spoke about the new posts to run alongside the pond for safety and beautification. Pond Commissioner Nanette Ecker mentioned the pond has never looked so good, even the wildlife has come back.

Building Department Updates: VC Ryder reported that there was a total of 23 (twenty-

three) building and plumbing permits filed since the last Board of Trustees meeting on

November 18<sup>th</sup>.

- Complaint Report: VC Ryder reported 7 complaints were filed in the last month. VC

Ryder mentioned that most of the complaints pertained to early construction start times

and landscapers working on the weekend.

- Old Business:

Security Cameras- Trustee Bruh reported all of our cameras are installed and the SIM

cards have been upgraded. Village Hall also has a new phone system called Ring Central

and Trustee Bruh is working on purchasing new phones and an Ipad for our security team.
